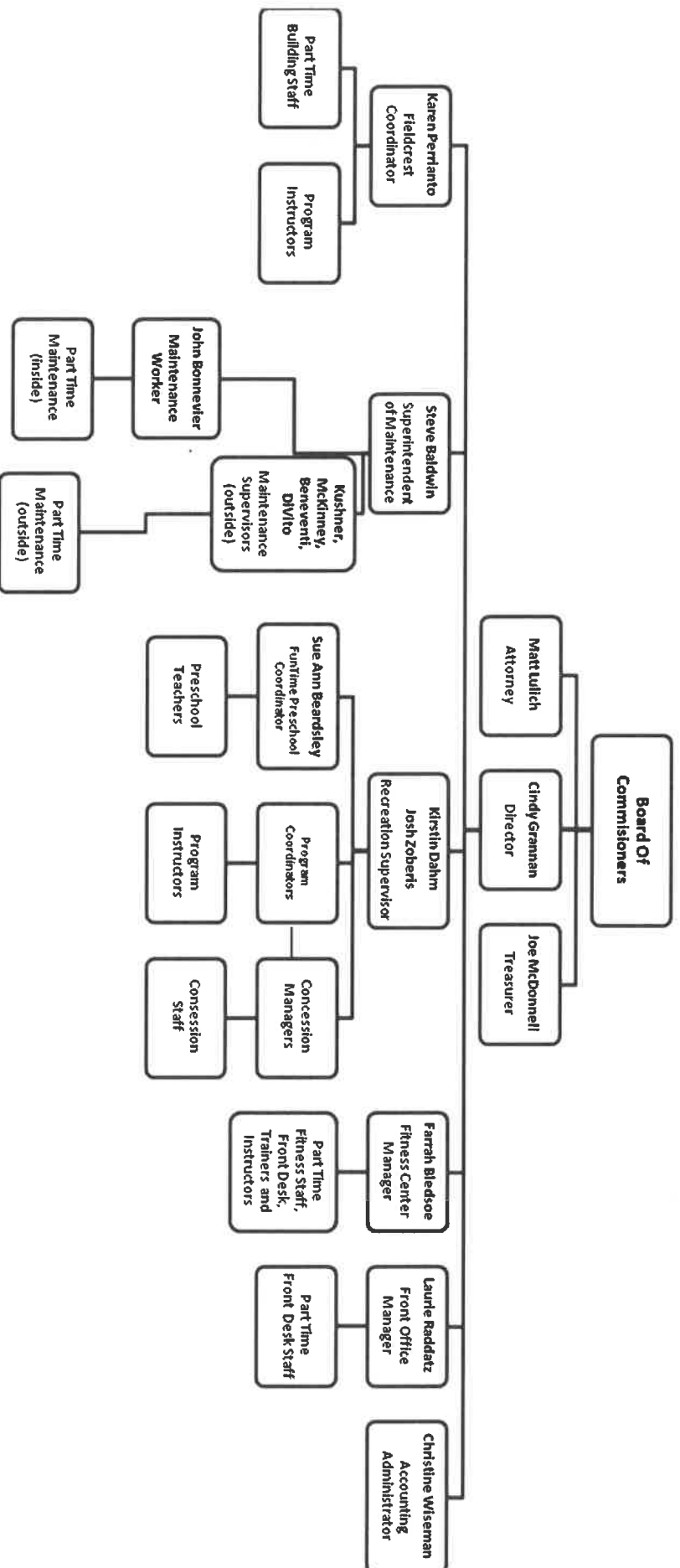

PUBLIC INFORMATION AND REQUEST POLICY

The Oak Forest Park District is a unit of local government founded in 1967.

The Mission of the Oak Forest Park District is dedicated to enhancing community morale by providing a variety of recreational opportunities, programs, special events, and trips which target all individuals in order for each to create and maintain a healthy lifestyle while doing so in a friendly and safe environment. Our goal is to involve the community and to inform the peoples of Oak Forest the many beneficial opportunities for recreation our Park District has to offer. We are also devoted to preserving open space as well as establishing and maintain the most modern equipment for our parks and facilities.

The Park District is governed by the following non-paid Board of Commissioners: James Emmett, President;, John Fitzsimons Vice-President; Joe Conway; Secretary; Charles Wolf, Commissioner and James Katula, Commissioner

The operating budget for the fiscal year ending 2015 is \$4,273,301. The Oak Forest Park District employs 138 full and part-time employees.

Any person requesting records of the Oak Forest Park District may make such a request in writing either in person, by mail, email or facsimile to the Freedom of Information Officer, Cindy Grannan, at the main office located at 15601 S. Central Avenue, Oak Forest, IL 60452, 708-687-9937 (fax). (See Exhibit A, Request for Public Records for a sample request.) If the Freedom of Information Officer is not present in person, the Administrative Assistant or the Front Desk Personnel will handle the request. If records must be certified, this must be indicated in the request. The fees for any such records, if the person requesting the records wished them to be copied, are as follows:

- No charge for the first fifty (50) black and white pages
- Over fifty (50) black and white copies: 1 cent per page
- Color copies: 6 cents per page
- Other than letter or legal size, actual cost of reproducing
- Electronic copies: cost of the medium
- \$1.00 to certify copies
