

Drive-In Movie Information & Guidelines

PARKING

- The Drive-In Movie site is located at Gaelic Park - 6119 147th St. This will be in the parking lot east of main parking lot.
- Drive-In Movie site will open at 6:00pm. Cars will not be allowed to park prior to 6:00pm. All vehicles must be parked by 7:00pm
- Entrance to the Drive-In Movie site will be off of 147th St.
- **For easier check-in process, please print/type your last name in all caps/bold letters on a piece of paper and display in the driver's side dash board window.**
- The person who's name that is registered for the movie, must be in the car when checking in. Registration may not be transferred to another person. If you are unable to attend the movie, please contact Kirstin Dahm at (708)687-7270 ext. 132 or by email at kdahm@oakforestparks.org , to cancel your spot so we can accommodate someone on the waitlist.
- As you enter, you will be directed to park to allow for proper social distancing.
- Larger vehicles, SUV, Minivans, and Trucks will be parked on the sides with smaller vehicles parked in the center.
- Motorcycles, RV's, Campers, and trailers are not allowed.
- Please arrive together to be parked if you are with another car that you would like to be parked next to, spaces cannot be held.
- You may have your back hatch open during the movie. Please notify parking staff if you would like to back your car into the space. **EVERYONE MUST REMAIN IN THEIR VEHICLE FOR THE DURATION OF THE MOVIE.**

SOUND

- Sound will be transmitted through an FM transmitter. We will announce the radio station to tune into so you can listen from your car radio. You are welcome to bring a radio from home.

RESTROOMS

- Port-a-lets will be available. Please maintain six (6) feet from others and wear a mask while going to and from the port-a-lets and while in line.

GUIDELINES

- **EVERYONE MUST REMAIN IN THEIR VEHICLE FOR THE DURATION OF THE MOVIE.**
- A mask must be worn at all times if you exit your vehicle.
- Social distancing of six (6) feet must be maintained at all times from others when you are out of your car and in line for the restroom.
- Socializing between vehicles is prohibited.
- Drive-ups without a confirmed pre-registration will not be allowed in.
- Walk-ins will not be allowed.
- Grills/grilling is not allowed.
- Pets are not allowed.
- Smoking is not allowed outside of your vehicle.
- To provide a safe event for all participants, we kindly ask that you stay home if you are not feeling well or are experiencing any symptoms related to COVID-19.
- Daytime running lights – in order for all to have a positive movie viewing, we are asking you to turn off your daytime running lights, after you are parked. If you are unable to turn off your daytime running lights, we suggest you bring black garbage bags and painters tape to cover your lights.
- Vehicles that leave the Drive-In Movie site will not be allowed to re-enter.
- At the end of the movie, you will be directed to exit onto 147th St. Please dispose of any trash in the trashcans.
- If there is inclement weather on the movie day and we have to cancel the event, we will notify you by email, by 5:00pm on the day of the event.

EMERGENCIES

- Inclement weather – an announcement will be made, if we need to stop the movie and evacuate the site.
- First Aid/Accident – limited first aid supplies; ice packs, band aids, will be available. If you need medical assistance please call 911 and notify a staff member.
